

### Instructions for the French Funfair Game

1. You need four players and each player needs a counter
2. You need a dice
3. Each player should place their counters on the entrance square to the funfair
4. The object of the game is to see who can get furthest around the funfair in the time your teacher gives you to play the game. You may find that you can get round the funfair more than once!
5. You could ask your teacher to put a countdown clock on the Interactive Whiteboard if they can to help you see how much time you have left.
6. Before you start the game you need to read the forfeits below – just in case you land on a specific square. Use bi-lingual dictionaries to help you understand the instructions and discuss amongst the other players on your board game .
7. Share your ideas about what the forfeits mean with the class and your teacher.
8. Now you are ready to play the game, but what do you need to throw to start.....? Look at the first forfeit below!
9. Watch out too for those numbered squares – you can either go forwards on them or if the number is a minus number .....sorry you have to go backwards that number of squares!
