1. Welcome and apologies

All welcomed to the group and agenda shared.

2. Finance update

Debby confirmed we have £7200 in the bank currently (lockers still to come out).

Circus raised £2800, lottery and clothing money coming in.

3. Events to discuss:

- **Colour Run – rainbow raffle** – date to wear own clothes 7th July for all children and to bring an item for the raffle the colour of their school house (white/blue/red/yellow). Parade starting at Alston lane school 12:15pm (little ones can meet at the village hall if too far to walk) – BFG, Willy Wonker & Matilda are themes (can use others costumes if have them). The garden party will have a craft stall to make things and wear bright colours if nothing else.

4. School wish list 2022/3

- Ordering lockers for years 4/5/6 to be put in this summer – Penny/Stuart to confirm final cost.
- Miss Cross has asked if we will cover the cost of the Y6 Francos meal (£307 last year). All confirmed yes we would.

- Mrs Coupe has been working alongside Lancashire Heritage – offering half day workshop sessions @ £95 each. Could the PTFA fund or support towards (every class would be £665) – one for 2024 academic year.
- Also raised have all year groups spent the £100 per class contribution for trips PTFA offered to fund – **Action: Penny to remind.**
