Languages Curriculum Overview 2023 – 24



At Grimsargh St Michael's we started using a new French scheme of work in September 2022. After seeking advice, it was decided that all classes would need to start at the beginning, at Year 3 level. Years 4, 5 and 6 are now all working at the Year 4 level this year, with Year 3 working at the Year 3 level.

In order for the children to really 'master' their language skills the phonics and grammar repeat in Years 3 & 4 and then again in Years 5 & 6. The vocabulary and activities vary so that lessons themselves are different.
