Dear Parents/ Carers,

Today your child should have brought home the mathematics, reading and grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) revision guides. These revision guides have been kindly bought by our PTFA and are for additional use at home to help your child practise and revise for the Year 6 Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs) in May. You will receive more information about these tests after half term.

The revision guides can be used as much as you deem suitable, however, we recommend that children use them 'little and often'. Each page has a 'What you need to know', 'Let's practise' and then a 'Try this' part. The 'Try this' section is a useful part for the children to have a go at some example questions. You can help your child at home by reading the questions and marking their answers using the answer pages at the back of the book. The books also have a useful introduction and a glossary at the back to support understanding of terminology.

You will notice that your child will have either brought home an achieving 'the expected standard' or a 'higher score' book. If your child has brought a 'higher score' book home, this means they are comfortably working within the expected standard for that area of the curriculum. Therefore, they are then aspiring to achieve the higher standard. However, it is important to note that this is aspirational, not definitive. There is a large step between achieving the expected standard and the higher standard; this is challenging to achieve for

most children. If your child has brought an 'expected standard' book home, this means that they are either just about working within this standard or aiming to achieve this standard. While using these revision guides, if you notice a particular area your child needs considerable support with, please let me know by either communicating in their reading diary or via email.
