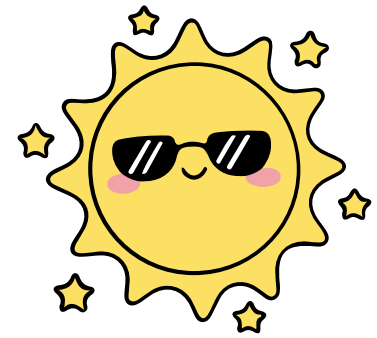




## YEAR 3 Summer NEWSLETTER 2026
