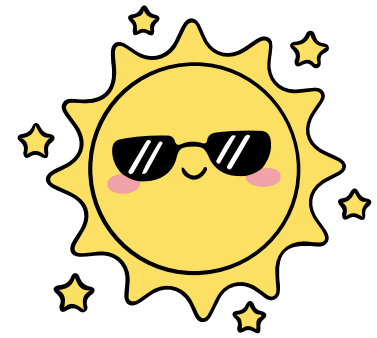




YEAR 3 Autumn NEWSLETTER 2026
